

## BURLINGTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2023 BURLINGTON TOWN HALL

- 1. Call to Order: Chairman Vince Lambri called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM. Present: Tom Finan, Vince Lambri, Richard Miller, Amelia Kearney, Jackie Shadford. Absent John Hebert and Tom Roberge.
- 2. Accept Minutes: Motion made and seconded to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes of October 18, 2023 Miller/Kearney. Approved. Finan abstained.
- 3. Citizen's Comments: None
- 4. Update on meeting of Lambri and First Selectman Thompson: Thompson communicated that going forward, the town's nip funds (a dedicated fund) from the State, will be allocated to nip related issues as defined by state statute dealing with the nip sales rebate. The fund will be used for town cleanups (including supplies), such an annual Earth Day cleanup or additional cleanup efforts.
