## Summer Fun Camp Features:

- Swimming for all day campers, only.
- Arts & craft time.
- Field sports and games.
- Each session has a different field trip or special event.
- Ability to attend swim lessons during summer camp, if registered.
- Low camper-to-counselor ratio.
- Lunch and snacks are not provided, kids bring their own.
- Each Monday a Camp Newsletter will be distributed to parents with pertinent information regarding the week's events.
- No Camp Registrations will be accepted after Thursday before each session.
- If a student is registered for daytime swim lessons during any portion of a camp session, counselors will be sure participants arrive for swim lessons and are brought back to camp activities.

## IMPORTANT CAMP DETAILS

- **DROP-OFF:** The earliest children may be dropped off for camp is 8:25 a.m. Parents must sign children in and out at Camp Tables. Upon check-in, if you indicate someone other than yourself will be picking up your child from camp, you will be asked to fill out a permission form.
- **WHAT TO WEAR:** Children should wear comfortable clothing to camp. **SNEAKERS ARE A MUST**, as they afford more protection than sandals. Bathing suits may be worn to camp or children may change into them for lessons and open swim (full day campers). On rainy days, please dress children warmly, as it tends to be cold under the pavilion. Children should wear or bring a hat and **LABEL EVERYTHING**.
- **SUNSCREEN:** Please apply waterproof sunscreen to your child prior to arrival at camp. We recommend you send sunscreen with them daily and teach your child how to re-apply sunscreen at camp to protect them from sunburn.
- **RED ZONE DAYS** or Extreme Heat Days are **WET & WILD** at camp. Many extra water activities are scheduled throughout the day. However, if heat becomes a hazard, we will eliminate active games.
- **LUNCH AND SNACKS:** Lunch and snacks are not provided. Children should bring snacks and lunch (if applicable) to camp each day. No glass bottles please, or items that require refrigeration.
- **MEDICATIONS:** Counselors and the Site Director are not permitted to dispense any medications. A parent must come to camp to dispense any medications.
- **CAMP NEWSLETTER:** A newsletter will be distributed on Mondays of each Camp Session not only detailing camp activities for the week, but also information on special events or field trips.
- **SPECIAL EVENTS/FIELD TRIPS:** A field trip or a special event will be planned for each session. Special event or field trip fees are included in the session fee.
- **THINGS NOT TO BRING TO CAMP!!** Campers are encouraged to keep personal items and valuables at home. No video games (Game Boy), C.D. Players, I-Pods, MP3 Players, Cell Phones, radios, skateboards, trading cards, hand-held electronic games, or anything valuable.
- **DISCIPLINE POLICY:** Our Staff adheres to a fair discipline policy; however, if a camper's behavior interferes with a positive camp experience for other campers, parents will be notified. If the behavior continues, parents will be asked to remove the child from camp with no refund.
- **ELECTIVE PERIOD:** Each Monday campers in Camp Adventure and Camp Burlington will choose an activity they would like to take part in throughout the week. The elective groups will change from week to week as our "super staff" share and teach the campers their special talents and interests.
- **LOST AND FOUND:** There will be a Lost and Found bin at the campsite. Please check weekly, as lost and found items will be disposed of at the conclusion of Session 4 and one week after the last session.
- **RAIN POLICY:** Camps are usually held under the pavilion on rain days. In case of predicted severe weather, we will use Lake Garda Elementary School (if available) as an alternative site, and parents will be asked to drop-off and pick-up their children at this site. Please call the Parks and Recreation Department, 673-6789 after 7:30 a.m., when the weather is questionable. When you reach the main message, our extension is 7. If a thunder and lightning storm occurs once camp begins, children must be picked-up immediately. Refunds will not be given if camp is canceled due to a storm.
- **PICK-UP:** Children must be picked up by 12:00 noon or 4:00 p.m., respectively. If a parent is consistently late picking up a child, they will be asked not to bring the child back to camp, and no refunds will be granted. Since safety is a key ingredient in all programs, we will not allow children to run into the Parking Lot for pick-up, rather parents or guardians must report to check out table. A child must have a note from a parent or guardian to be allowed to walk or bike home, or be picked up by someone other than a parent or guardian. No exception will be made without a note. When your child is picked up from Camp by the designated person, they will be asked to provide identification (driver's license).
