

Town of Burlington Recycling Center Fees

Recycling Drop-off Fees

- Non-contaminated oil - NO CHARGE
- Anti-freeze - NO CHARGE
- Scrap metal - \$20 and up per item or per load
- Appliances - \$15 each
- Batteries - \$5 each
- Tires - \$5 each no rim, \$15 each with rim, \$15 each no rim truck tires
- Brush - \$15 per yard
- Mattress or box spring - \$5 each
- Boilers or water tanks - \$15 each
- Couches or chairs - \$10 each
- Air conditioners - \$10 each
- Refrigerators and freezers - \$20 each
- Residential construction debris - \$50 and up per load
- Minimum load (miscellaneous) - \$35
- Household garbage - \$1 per small bag, \$2 per large bag
- Shingles - \$100 and up per load
- Propane tanks - \$7 each small tank, \$35 each large tank
- Toilet/sinks (porcelain) - \$5 each

Recycling Electronic Equipment Fees

Group 1: \$3,00 each

- Cell phones
- Remote controls
- Pagers
- Keyboards/mouse/peripherals
- Digital cameras
- PDAs
- Speakers
- Telephones
- Two-way radios
- Answering machines
- Camcorders

Group 2: \$8,00 each

- Monitors
- Desktop printers
- Fax machines
- PCs

Group 3: \$1,00 each

- Fluorescent bulbs

Group 4: \$5,00 each

- CD players
- DVD players/VCRs
- Electronic typewriters
- Game systems
- Laptops
- Stereos/tape players

Group 5:

- Refrigerator \$20 each
- Air conditioners/humidifiers \$10 each

Group 6: \$14,00 each

- TVs less than 27"

Group 7: \$16,00 each

- TVs greater than 27"

Group 8: \$3,00/lb (est.)

- Batteries
