8-25-1924, Bristol Press. It may be literally said that Burlington Center began a new era Thursday evening for the first time when the electric current was turned on the new line to the Center. The line comes from Unionville and the power is supplied by the Union Light & Power Company of that place.

It may be again be mentioned that the State Fish & Game Hatchery was the means of securing this improvement for the State stepping in that made possible the raising of the needed guarantee to secure the service.

Now that the lights are in Burlington Center they will probably follow Whigville's experience and have a multitude of opportunities to purchase washing machines, vacuum cleaners and similar articles. Indeed the benefits of these labor saving devices in the home almost equals the advantage of the lighting service. It is noteworthy that within a period of about nine months both Whigville and Burlington Center sections have obtained electric light service. The Collinsville section of the town has had this service for many years from the line of the Union Light & Power Company.
