Updates on proposed business/property developments: 276 Spielman Highway, 713 George Washington Turnpike, Prospect Street: Kallenbach presented updates on: 276 Spielman Highway (Burlington Spirit Shoppe proposed building development scheduled for Planning & Zoning Commission public hearings), 713 George Washington Turnpike (Bullet Trap USA industrial building for lease or sale), and Lot 33 Prospect Street (Burlington Solar One, LLC petition to Connecticut Siting Council for solar project on vacant land parcel).
