- B. Jurisdictional Review-Lavender Farm-61 Nepaug Road-Laura and Jason Pennell, homeowners, were present and addressed the Commission. GIS map provided. In 2021 they are looking to plant rows of lavender in front of the property. Some tilling will be done, very dry soil, no raised beds needed. Complete organic operation with no chemicals used. Future plantings will be done in rear of house using raised beds and an Application and drainage plans will be needed. Gazebo will need to be moved out of FEMA zone. Commission and ZEO were in agreement that the home owners were able to complete project in front of house only at this time.
