**Director's Report: Budget -** Current budget reviewed, expenditures on track for time of year (approx. 42%) Proposed 2020 Budget - proposing increases in Books/Subscriptions by \$10,000 to \$35,000, Electricity, Building Maintenance, and Telephone/Communications (small increases in most). Additional money added for Programming - adults, children and teens in the amount of \$3,000. Total increases of \$16,220 Proposed 2020 Capital Budget - Six computers with software Motion to approve the updated budget proposal by Tricia Galvin, seconded by Laura Hedenberg

Summary statement for FY 2018-19: \$908 from CT State Library, and \$7,267 from fines and fees. Discussion about proposing a joint venture with Region 10 to provide a summer reading experience (Reading Camp) that targets Burlington students (grades 1-3) that have lagging reading ability. Has potential for a Parker Grant proposal 2020.

Hiring for Local History Room: Interviews have taken place and there is a candidate that the committee is interested in pursuing (8 hours a week) Teen Librarian: One potential candidate
