- Malerbo Parking: Director Twomey has received complaints from Malerbo neighbors concerned about the parking at Malerbo and on neighborhood streets. There was also a suggestion of assigning teams at Fields F and G to park at Lake Garda. This will need to be worked on for the spring and moving forward.
