Burlington Park and Recreation Commission Minutes of Meeting September 6, 2017

• Call to Order

Commissioner Stawarz called meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Commissioners also present: Millerick, Van Buren, Ronalter, Mayes, Parente, Dolzadelli, and Director Tricia Twomey.

- Minutes of August 16, 2017, Meeting Motion made and accepted to approve. (Van Buren/Ronalter, unanimous but for Parente, Mayes who abstained.)
- Public Comment No public in attendance.
- Financial Report Budget in line for 2018, no issues to report.
 - P&R returned 20,574.22, primarily due to town spending freeze that disallowed use of funds.
 - \$75,000 in revenue returned to town General Fund
 - Considering state budget-driven freeze, budget is fine; \$60,000 returned to town due to summer programming, with \$20,000 due by end of FY18. Expect to meet this goal and drive additional revenue for P&R projects.

• Fall Programming

- Registration is closed for Golf and Total Body Fitness programs (which already started) but all other fall programs are open for registration.

• Facilities Update

- Nassahegan and Malerbo are reopened for play.
- Both fields grew in well
- New goals for micro teams are in place
- Fields are marked
- Malerbo baseball scoreboard is delivered and will be mounted as soon as possible
- Baseball, softball schedules still needed
- Foote Road closed for season, docks, trash, buoy lines moved in. Facility being used on weekends for rentals by residents.
- Johnnycake Mountain Park Discussion
 - Land Trust request walking and hiking trails and history of area. Working on clearing space for parking, and marking out spaces for trails.
 - No plans for use for fall practice fields at this time.
 - Planning to use for ice skating this year.
