BURLINGTON CURBSIDE RECYCLE & TRASH COLLECTION INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE ALL GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES MUST BE CURBSIDE BY 6:00 AM ON THE DAY OF COLLECTION

Weekly Curbside Trash (Green Bin) and Bi-Weekly Recycle (Blue Bin) Collection - If New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, or Christmas falls on a weekday, curbside trash and recycle collection will run one day late. All other holidays will be a regular pickup week. There is a fee for an extra trash or recycle bin (\$95 for the barrel and \$175 for yearly usage charge). Bi-Weekly Curbside Recycling - Blue Bin: NO PLASTIC BAGS

Cleaned metal, cardboard, and glass food containers
Corrugated cardboard folded flat to 2' X 3'

Papers: newspapers, magazine, office paper, catalogs
Plastic containers #1-#7.

Refrigerators, air conditioners, humidifiers need stickers in order to be picked up at curbside. Purchase stickers from the Town Clerk. **NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS. NO CONTRACTOR'S CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS ACCEPTED. DUMPSTERS ARE REQUIRED ON SITE.**

Please recycle mindfully. Do not contaminate your recycling bin with inappropriate trash. When recycling, use this saying, "WHEN IN DOUBT THROW IT OUT". Contaminated recycling is very costly for the town. PLASTIC BAGS GO IN REGULAR TRASH.

DRY Mattresses and Box Springs will be accepted at the Town Recycle Center at no charge; however, a fee of \$15 will be assessed for each wet Mattress or Box Spring. Mattresses and Box Springs will **NOT** be accepted at curbside at any time.

Alkaline batteries may be thrown out in regular trash.

Fees will be charged for the following accepted materials:

- Air Conditioners, Chairs and Couches \$10 each
- Appliances, Boilers and Water Tanks \$15 each
- Car Batteries \$5
- Car and Truck Tires with Rim \$15 Without Rims \$5 each
- Propane tanks \$10
- Scrap Metal-depends on quantity
- Shingles \$100 a load of average size
- All Residential Construction Debris \$35 and up per load
- Brush \$25 Per Yard
- Wet Mattress or Box Spring \$15 each
- Refrigerators \$20 Small Dorm Refrigerators \$10

****FEES ARE SUBJECT TO ADJUSTMENT****

Fees will not be charged for the following accepted materials:

- Computers, monitors
- Other electronic devices
- Oil and water based paints in original containers
- Oil, anti-freeze, and cardboard
- Television
- Leaves will be accepted free of charge during Recycle Center hours in April, May, October, and November
- DRY Mattress or Box Spring

Household Composting is encouraged.

Hazardous Waste Collection: acids, bases, flammables, pesticides, solvents, aerosol paints. Shellacs, strippers, batteries, household chemicals. Smoke detectors are not accepted. Check for dates of collection in various towns. Check the town website for locations.
