<u>Old Business</u>: Jim submitted all the necessary paperwork to the Burlington Community Fund (formerly called the Burlington Bell) and they submitted it to the Main Street Foundation.

The first appointment with the members of the Fund will be Thursday, October 11 at the Library. Jim encouraged us to attend.

New Business: In Donna's absence Tricia reported that Donna is exploring the feasibility of expanding the senior housing complex. She has met with the town engineer to discuss site planning.

Art suggested current residents be interviewed to see what they would recommend for new apartments based on what they like and don't like now. The addition of carports, garages and laundry facilities will be discussed.

Also, there are pros and cons of moving the Senior Center there.

We discussed whether Burlington residents could have priority if there was a waiting list but it was unknown if fair housing laws may prevent that.
