December 27th is the New Year luncheon. Tricia is working on entertainment. The piano needs several more tunings before it is in good shape to play.

There will not be another flu clinic this year.

**Community Fund Update:** We were excited to hear that the Community Fund has awarded us with the funds we proposed. There was some discussion on different options for the new equipment and accessories.

Jim said once the computers have been purchased we will need an action plan for training people and rules for usage.

**Tax Abatement**: Beth Paul has readjusted the numbers to make them more current. Tricia would like to meet again before the BOF meeting.

<u>New Business</u>: Art spoke with someone in the State Trooper's Office regarding having a drug box available year-round. He would also like to see if CVS would take back unwanted meds.

Art asked if it could be included in the newsletter that the Food Pantry needs more volunteers. Due to the large amount of donations there is plenty of food right now but they are lacking the space to put it in and the volunteers to sort it.
