Tricia went over some of the winter programs that have been perennial favorites.

**Community Fund Update:** The check has arrived. Plans will be made soon for purchasing and installing the new computers.

**Tax Abatement:** Tricia has made up a packet of information to be given to each BOF member so that they can discuss it at their next meeting. Jim would like us to attend the meeting if possible.

<u>New Business</u>: Lori asked what has happened with the proposed trail around the fields at Lake Garda Elementary.

There is a new water fountain and bike rack but there is no actual marked path yet.
