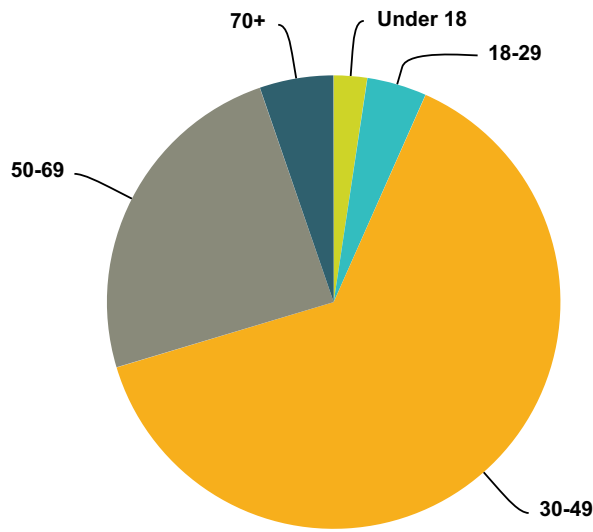

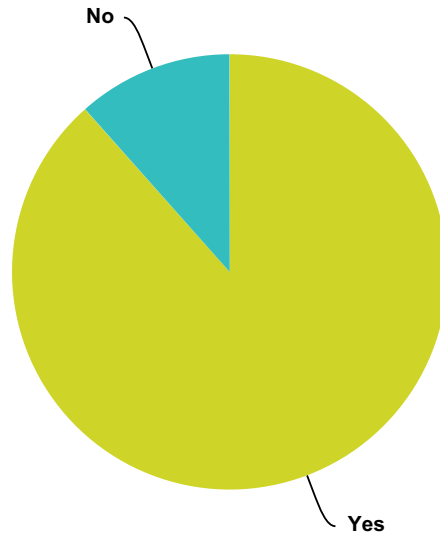

### Q3 Are you a resident of Burlington?

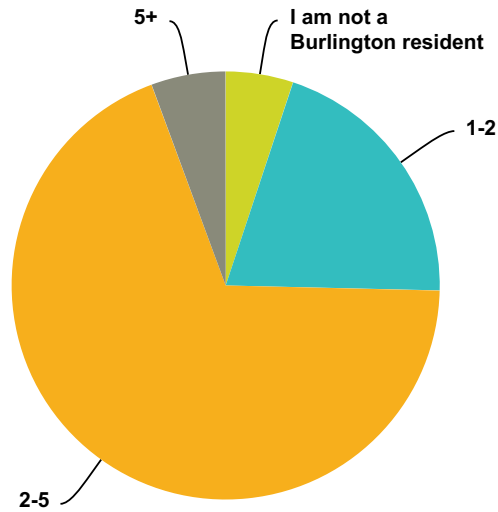

### Q4 How many people live in your household?

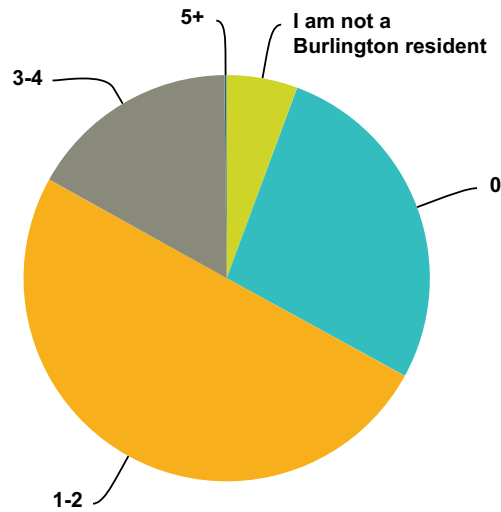

### Q5 How many children (under age 18) live in your household?

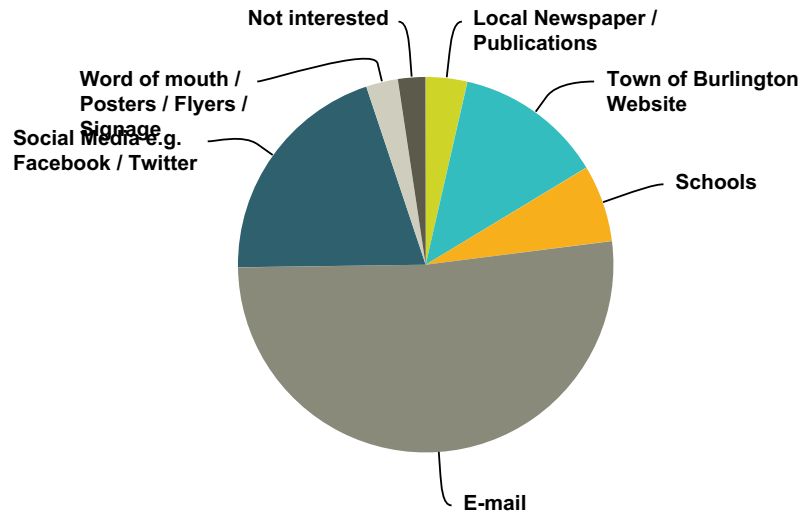

### Q6 How would you like to be informed about recreational events and opportunities within the Town of Burlington?

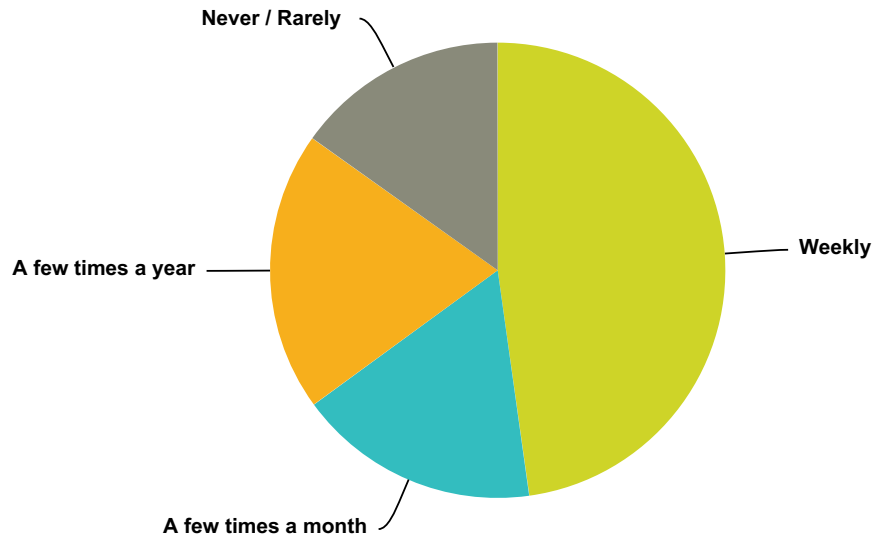

**Q7 How often do you or a member of your household use Burlington active recreation facilities? (Athletic fields, courts, and playground areas are considered active recreation.)**

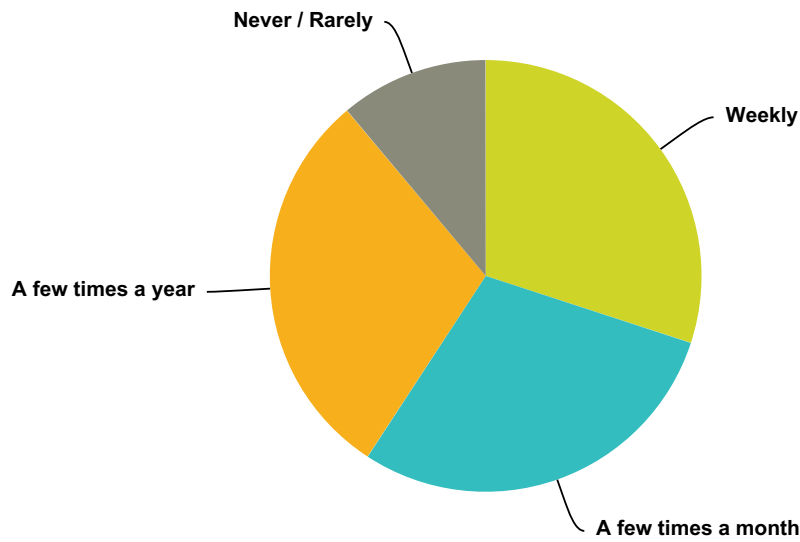

**Q8 How often do you or a member of your household use Burlington passive recreation facilities? (Hiking, walking, or fishing is considered passive recreation.)**

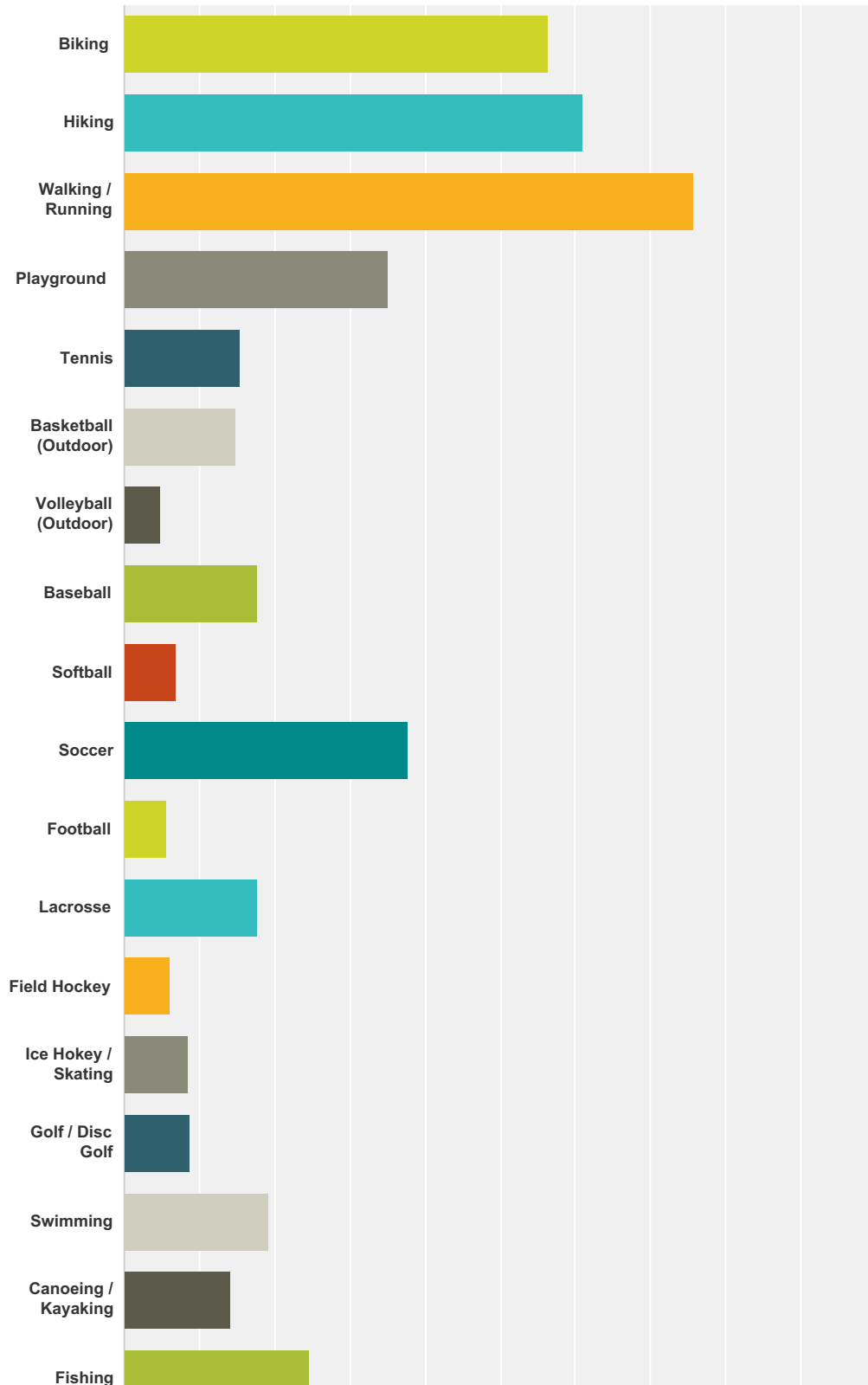

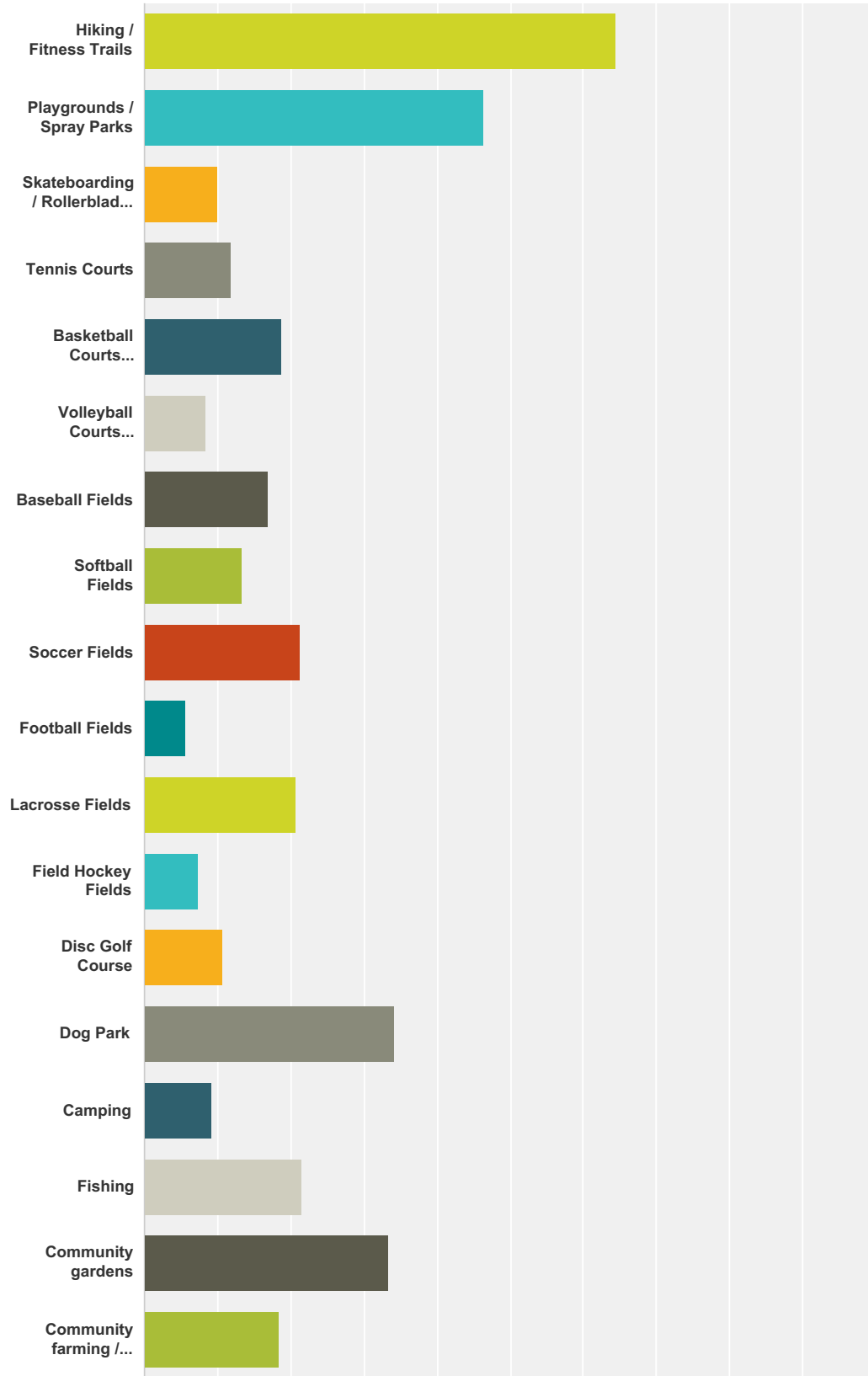

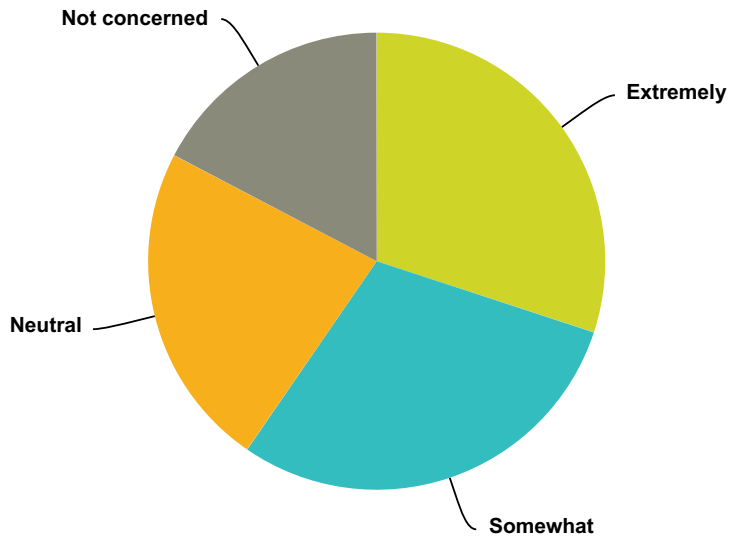

### Q18 Are you concerned about the use of pesticides and herbicides for the maintenance of turf grass on park fields?

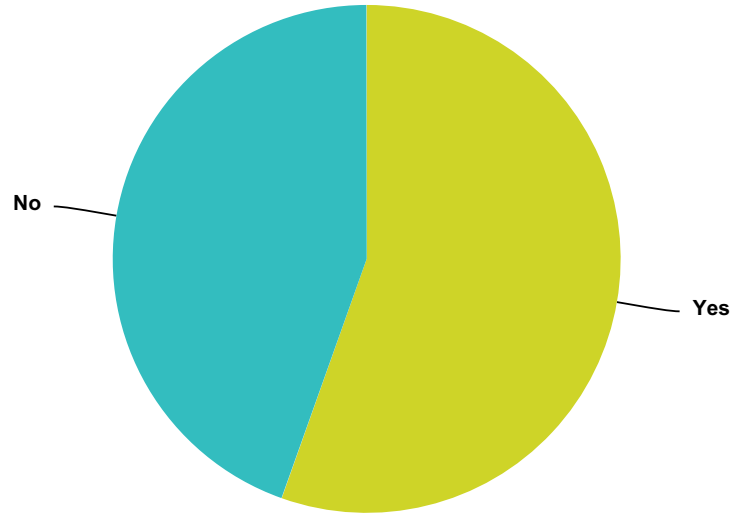

### Q19 Do you feel that the Town of Burlington is currently investing enough resources into parks, open spaces, and athletic fields?

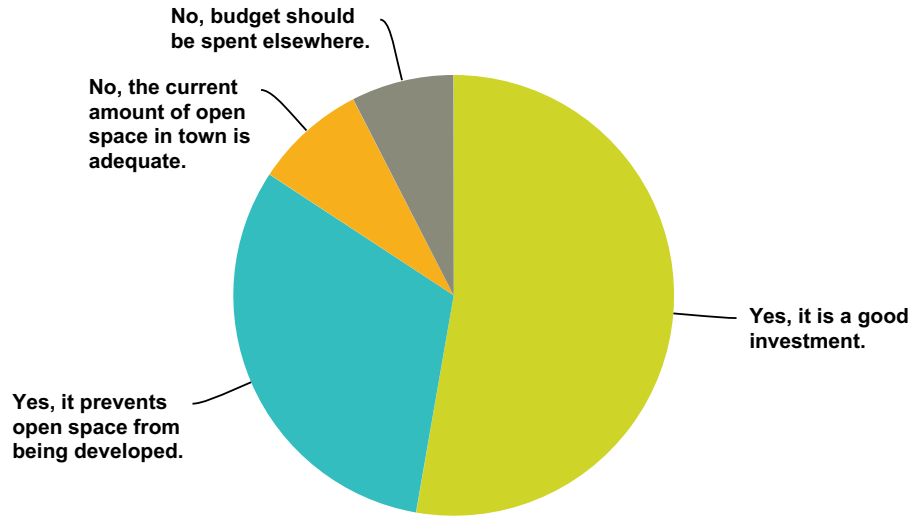

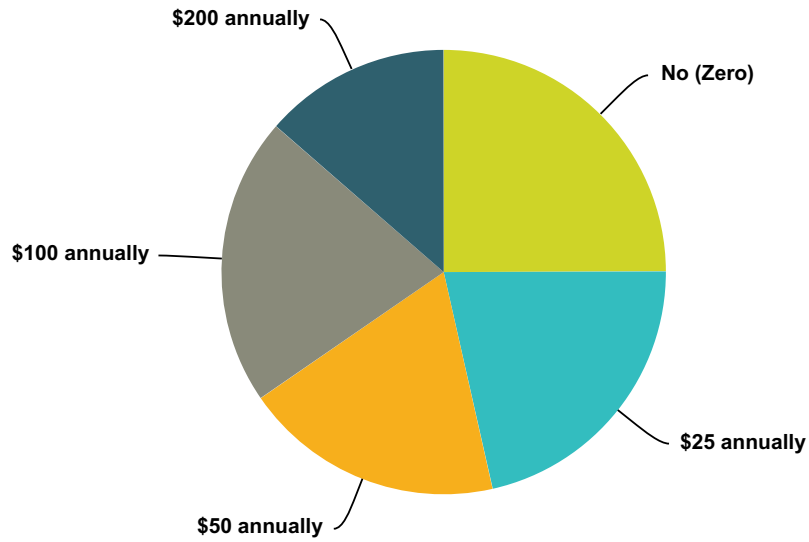
