

Informational Session Regarding Recommendations from the Ordinance Committee

After the conclusion of the annual Town Meeting on Monday, January 23, 2017, the Ordinance Committee will hold an informational session regarding its recommendations to the Board of Selectmen. The Committee intends to discuss the process by which it is collaborating with General Code, which is a vendor that is assisting the Committee in reviewing and codifying the existing Town Ordinances. Additionally, the Committee will discuss the following ordinances that are in the process of being drafted:

Agriculture Commission – creates an advisory commission that is charged with, among other things, serving as a resource for local farmers and residents.

Right to Farm – encourages the pursuit of agriculture and protects farmland by recognizing the right to farm in Town.

Alarm Systems – regulates excessive home security system false alarms that necessitate the response of emergency personnel.

Alcoholic Beverages – prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages on Town property without a permit.

Drone Ordinance – regulates the use of drones, which are unmanned aircraft operated by remote control.

Peddlers and Hawkers – proposes to substantially revise the existing Peddlers and Hawkers ordinance, regulating persons selling goods door-to-door or from a temporary location within Town.

Public Place Ordinance – regulates certain activities on property owned, managed or controlled by the Town.

Winter Sidewalk and Hydrant Maintenance – regulates the maintenance of sidewalks and hydrants during winter weather conditions.
