

The hike begins at the 2-3 car parking area (A) on the unpaved cul-de-sac at the end of Cornwall Road (41.745952, -72.956430). There is also parking at B on the paved cul-de-sac 0.2 miles north. (Do not block the mail box #175). Begin hiking on the Blue / Yellow Trail (B/Y- note photo of the plastic marker) heading due east, crossing a a brook using stepping stones. At 0.5 miles, turn left at a new sign (photo) that marks the start of the Blue / Green Trail (B/G) This trail has newly painted trail blazes with green dots that are easy to follow. It carries on the 50+ year history of using colored painted dots to identify the other hiking choices on Connecticut's Blue Trail system. The Blue / Green Dot Trail ends at the "T" junction with the Blue / White trail (B/W) at 1.3 miles. Turn left on the B/W trail to reach Cornwall Road at 1.4 miles. Turn left and follow this Road back to your car at 2.2 miles.

Mileage summary: Hike the B/Y east then north 0.5 miles & turn left on B/G trail > turn left on B/W trail at 1.3 miles> turn left on Cornwall Road at 1.4 & return to car at 2.2
