



The Brower Loop

Class 1

1.0 miles
160' vertical
0.5 hours

The hike begins at the 5 car parking lot on Greer Road next to Brower Pond. Hike south passing the Burlington Land Trust information kiosk. This 43 acre Martha Bower Nature Preserve was given to the BLT in 2001. The hike begins on the Tunxis Blue and Yellow Dot Trail (B/Y) but turns west at 0.2 miles onto the Red Trail (R) created by the BLT. Be sure to notice the 25 trees that are identified along the entire trail. The R trail merges back onto the B/Y at 0.6 miles for a short distance and then continues east as the B/Y continues south. The last section of the R trail provides 3 viewpoints of Brower Pond. Be sure to locate the beaver lodge and bird life at the pond. Note the satellite photo of the property was taken at the end of 2016 which was a dry year and the pond had a very low water level.

Mileage summary
follow B/Y turning right onto R at 0.2 >
merge with B/Y at 0.6 >
continue east on R as B/Y goes south >
note the 3 views of Brower Pond >
turn left on Greer Road >
return to you car at 1.0
