BURLINGTON WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY MEETING MINUTES Wednesday, September 18, 2019 Burlington Town Hall

- 1. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 7:15 PM. Commissioners present were: Chairman Bill Parente, Paul Bystrak, Eric Eggleston, Charles Lanfair, Jim Grappone, John Jozwik, and Steve Perry. Also present was Beverly Jackson and Matthew Jermine, PE, Fuss & O'Neill. New commissioner Steve Perry was welcomed to the board.
- 2. Act on the Minutes from May 15, 2019 Motion made, seconded and passed unanimously to approve Meeting Minutes of August 15, 2019, with the amount of gallons changed to 300,000 in section 3. (Bystrak/Jozwik) Lanfair abstained.
- 3. Farmington Flow Meter Motion made, seconded and passed unanimously to move agenda item 6-Farmington Flow Meter up. (Jozwik/Lanfair) Matthew Jermine, PE, Fuss & O'Neill updated the commission and is working on an alternative solution to include Circle Drive and East Shore Boulevard as requested by Farmington. The Commission wants to calculate the average daily flow for residents on West Side Boulevard in the sewer shed area to estimate the equivalent dwelling units (EDU). The Building Department and Scott Tharau have an issue with new sewer connections and the final inspection which will be on a future agenda. Will also address On-Call agreement in upcoming meetings. Motion made, seconded and approved to accept and submit Invoice #215597 for \$2,436.93 and Invoice #0214262 for \$14,170.85, both from Fuss & O'Neill. (Jozwik/Bystrak)
