

BURLINGTON WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY MEETING MINUTES Wednesday, November 20, 2019 Burlington Town Hall

- 1. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Commissioners present were: Chairman Bill Parente, Paul Bystrak, Eric Eggleston, Charles Lanfair, Jim Grappone and Steve Perry. Also present was Allison Tharau.

Alfred Smith to draft letter to Russ Arnold in Farmington. Invite Atty Alfred Smith to Dec 18th meeting to discuss in Executive Session.

Interoffice Communications Update- Chairman Parente referred Commissioners to the email dated October 23, 2019 from Matthew Jermine with the 3 links to Farmington Treatment Plant Upgrade information with timeline of project and details of design and implementation. A discussion on zero call agreement was discussed. A contractor needs to be secured for final sewer inspections, lateral inspections and monitoring of flow meter flume.
